FUSRAP LUCKEY SITE STATUS

BUFFALO, NY – The US Army Corps of Engineers, Buffalo District, will be sampling the groundwater monitoring wells at the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) Luckey Site located at 21200 Luckey Road in Luckey, Ohio, in August. Groundwater sampling is performed annually to verify current groundwater conditions as required in the 2008 Groundwater Record of Decision (ROD) for the site.

“Later this year, we will further define the extent of FUSRAP-related soil contamination on the site by performing soil sampling and geophysical and topographic surveys,” said Duane Lenhardt, Luckey Site Project Manager. The results from this work will provide the Corps with the necessary data to enter the Remedial Design Phase of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) Process which the Corps follows when implementing FUSRAP. “This data is required to complete our remedial design, update the estimated cost associated with the cleanup, and proceed to environmental remediation,” continued Lenhardt. Completion of these field studies is scheduled for the end of 2009.

During Remedial Design work plans will be developed to execute the next phase in the CERCLA Process which is Remedial Action. Excavation and removal of FUSRAP contaminated soils from the Luckey Site to meet the 2006 site soils ROD objectives will be scheduled based on the availability of funds within FUSRAP. Remediation activities will ensure cleanup of FUSRAP-related contamination in the soil and groundwater to levels suitable for unrestricted use.
