## Cultural Resources



### Cultural resources:

Any prehistoric or historic district, site, building, structure or object that evidences of human occupation or activity that is important in the history, architecture, or archaeology of a community or region. This includes properties of traditional religious and cultural importance to an Indian Nation or Native Hawaiian organization.



### Area of Potential Effect (APE):

The geographic area within which an undertaking may directly or indirectly cause alterations in the character or use of historic properties (National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) eligible or listed archaeological sites, standing structures, etc.). Depending on the nature of the various project components and the resources that may be affected, the APE may be different for the different kinds of effects caused by the project. An example is use of a Findlay quarry to dispose soil excavated during project construction.



### Historic properties:

Any prehistoric or historic district, site, building, structure or object, listed in, or eligible for listing in the NRHP maintained by the Secretary of the Interior (including artifacts, records and remains that are related to/located within such properties). It also includes properties of traditional religious and cultural importance to an Indian Nation or Native Hawaiian organization and that are listed in, or eligible for listing in the NRHP.
