

Guterl Specialty Steel Corporation History

- 1948 Simonds Saw and Steel Company 1956 milled 25-35 million pounds of uranium and 30-45 thousand pounds of thorium
- 1974 FUSRAP authorized
- 1979 Radiological survey completed for DOE by Oak Ridge National Laboratory






Guterl Specialty Steel Corporation History (Continued)

- 1997 Corps assigned FUSRAP
- 1999 Property owner commissioned Oak Ridge Institute for Science and Education to perform a radiological survey
- 2000 Preliminary Assessment assigned to Corps by DOE





Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) Process for FUSRAP



A removal action may be initiated at any time during the process if human health or the environment is in immediate danger.
