Corps Issues Record of Decision for Linde Groundwater

BUFFALO, NY-3/11/07)-The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (the Corps) has issued the Record of Decision (ROD) for the Linde Groundwater Operable Unit, Tonawanda, New York. The former Linde Site, now Praxair, is located at 175 East Park Drive, Tonawanda, New York.

The Corps, as lead agency for the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP), has determined that no action is necessary to protect public health, welfare, or the environment. No action is warranted because there are no exposure pathways to human or environmental receptors for any FUSRAP eligible contaminants of concern in the affected groundwater.

Responses to comments received on the Linde Groundwater Proposed Plan that was released for public comment in May 2006 are addressed in the Record of Decision Responsiveness Summary.
