Work is moving forward to obtain critical additional data required to proceed with environmental remediation at the Luckey Site, as well as completing remediation cost estimates associated with the cleanup.

A contract in the amount of \$719,394.43 for this work was awarded on July 15, 2009 to TPMC-EnergySolutions Environmental Services, LLC, an 8(a) joint-venture, small, disadvantaged company comprised of Terranear PMC and Energy Solutions located in Oak Ridge, TN.

Lieutenant Colonel Daniel B. Snead, Buffalo District Commander said, "The Corps is responsible to the American public to ensure we use appropriated funds in a way that maximizes value to the nation. This is a needed shot in the arm for the project and the economy."
