

## **Luckey Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program Site News from the Corps**

Hello from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Buffalo District:

During 2015, the Buffalo District awarded a \$100 million contract for cleanup of contaminated soils at the Luckey Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program Site, located near Luckey, Ohio. The contractor is currently finalizing the many work plans it must complete before work begins. Implementing these plans will ensure the cleanup is safely performed in a manner that is protective of site workers, the local community, and the environment.

In late September the Buffalo District awarded a task order on the contract, which funds the setup of site infrastructure and equipment necessary for work to begin. Sampling required before cleanup begins will be conducted during the next few months, while infrastructure setup will be during the spring 2017. Cleanup of FUSRAP-contaminated soils will follow.

We will be conducting a public availability poster session in the spring to update you about the remediation work, including the safety precautions that will be implemented and the methods that will be used for the cleanup.
