Hello from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Buffalo District:

The district is pleased to announce the release of the feasibility study and proposed plan for the Interim Waste Containment Structure Operable Unit of the Niagara Falls Storage Site (NFSS). The proposed plan documents the Corps of Engineers' preferred alternative for the Interim Waste Containment Structure Operable Unit, which is Alternative 4, excavation, partial treatment, and off-site disposal of the entire contents of the IWCS. You are encouraged to review and provide your comments on the proposed plan. The comment period for the proposed plan begins December 7, 2015, and ends February 6, 2016.

A public meeting will be conducted at the Town of Lewiston Senior Center, 4361 Lower River Road, Youngstown, NY 14171, on Wednesday, January 13, 2016, beginning at 6:30 p.m. The agenda follows:

- 8:00 p.m. – Public comments recorded
