SUBSTANCE FROM NIAGARA FALLS STORAGE SITE VICINITY PROPERTY G

Reference: Department of Energy: Letter to Mr. Gable from Lowell Campbell,  
Dated December 7, 1987

The referenced letter indicated that DOE was in the process of negotiations with several hazardous waste management firms within New York State for disposal of the 90 drums of soil which is not radiologically contaminated. On 1/18/88 a purchase order was issued to Chemical Waste Management, Inc. for disposal of the 90 drums of soil at their Model City, NY facility. The drums currently stored at the Niagara Falls Storage Site will be removed from the site over the next two weeks.
