The 2009 1st Quarter Niagara Falls Storage Site (NFSS) Environmental Surveillance Program data is now available for your review at:

- Spring 2008 Groundwater, Surface Water and Sediment (separate files for each parameter)
- 2008 Radon Gas Concentrations
- 2008 External Gamma Radiation Dose Rates
- 2009 1st Quarter Water Level Measurements

The Corps issued the NFSS Remedial Investigation (RI) Report in December 2007. Based upon findings from the RI and public comments received, the Corps enhanced the protectiveness of the Environmental Surveillance Program by increasing the frequency and parameters of some sampling events on-site. The 2008 Environmental Surveillance Program Technical Memorandum will be available this fall.
