The NFSS environmental surveillance reports for 1994 and 1995 have suddenly appeared on the old RAB NFSS intranet web site - up until this week all of the NFSS environmental surveillance reports were posted here, except for the years 1994 and 1995. Is this in response to public comment? Did USACE have the reports and not know it, or have to obtain the environmental surveillance reports for 1994 and 1995 from DOE?

I'm puzzled why these reports are now posted on the LOOW Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) intranet site and not the current NFSS web site, which is where USACE has posted all documents since ceasing to recognize the RAB a number of years ago. (I still use the intranet sites for LOOW and NFSS since the sites allow access to reference documents which would otherwise be unavailable to RAB members, who are unable to easily visit the Lewiston and Youngstown libraries.) Please consider posting the 1994 and 1995 NFSS surveillance reports on the public web site as well as on the USACE NFSS intranet site, so the public may have access.

The issue of public access to information is important: had the public had been made aware of the NFSS performance monitoring reports twenty years ago, community concerns about the integrity of the Interim Waste Containment Structure (IWCS) would have been validated a long time ago. I would also like to take the opportunity of again requesting that all of the NFSS performance monitoring reports be posted on the USACE NFSS web site: currently only the 1986 to 1990 reports have been made available to the public.
