On Saturday, October 2, 2010, 9:30 AM, a Public Meeting will be held at the Lewiston, Senior Citizens Center, 4361 River Road,

to discuss the LOOW property status. This meeting is a part of a New York State Department of Environmental Conservation grant awarded to the Buffalo Niagara Riverkeeper.
