Let me first thank [REDACTED] for a very detailed reply to my request for building plans. Please take the time to read his posting (below) because it does encapsulate the reason for my request. And yes, I do totally agree that a delay is not what I am looking for.

Specifically I am looking for "blue prints" for the "water treatment plant". And if I may be more specific the "Site Plan" and or the "foundation call-outs" would be more helpful than the actual structural plans of the building itself. Since there is most likely a very small chance that these documents actually exist for the LOOW, is it possible to see if these documents exist at any of the other Army facilities that built the same type of water treatment facility in the same time frame?

This is not a formal FOIA and there is no rush in finding this documentation. Paul seems to think that [REDACTED] is the person to ask and I have never known [REDACTED] to be incorrect. If there is another avenue to be taken please just point me in the right direction. If you need a freedom of information then I can do that too.

It just seems to me that knowing what the design specs were back in 1940s gives you a heads up when you want to make future plans for this site.
