The NFSS Environmental Surveillance Technical Memorandum documents the results of our monitoring program at the site from December 2008 to December 2009.

This program quantifies and evaluates radiological, chemical, and water quality data from the environment at the NFSS. The 2009 Technical Memorandum indicates that measured parameters were within U. S. Department of Energy guidelines and calculated exposure rates to the general public were well within regulatory limits.

NFSS controls are continuing to perform as designed and are fully protective of human health and the environment. These findings are consistent with the findings of prior year evaluations.
