I am one of the most non technical guys at that meeting last night, but that being said, I do follow and understand most of it :-) One opinion I came away with was, the Corp does not think the containment site is leaking at this time, and is changing its verbiage from plume to contamination "interesting".

Now this is a minor detail, but it goes to over all creditability - In slide # 10 the slide shows 6-mile creek going into 4- mile creek - that might be the southwestern drainage ditch. This runs south of the containment facility and could carry contamination to the west and then north.

The area covered was too small. The topography (hope I have the right spelling - the lay of the land) As the Building Inspector for the Town said, ground water likely flows from the east to the west due to both CWM and Modern.
