On Thursday, August 11, 2011 at 5:30 pm, a Public Meeting will be held at the Lewiston Senior Citizens Center to discuss the AFP-68 property status. This meeting is a part of a New York State Department of Environmental Conservation grant awarded to Buffalo Niagara Riverkeepers. This meeting is a follow up to the first AFP-68 meeting held in October 2010 to provide a technical opinion of the Air Force Plant 68 property.

Environmental Remediation Financial Services (ERFS, LLC) staff has spent the past several months reviewing additional documents and data provided by public and private organizations involved with the characterization and remediation of the various properties contained within and near the 7500 acres of the LOOW properties.

All interested persons are encouraged to attend this meeting to gain a status report on the remedial assessments and developing activities. This meeting will include a discussion of the work performed by the various agencies and private contractors during the past year. It will also provide you the opportunity to express your concerns on what is required to ensure effective remediation of the LOOW properties.
