Main findings from the research and investigations performed for the NFSS RIR Addendum are as follows:

- a. The Interim Waste Containment Structure is performing as designed,
- b. Groundwater contamination is not migrating laterally, and
- c. Plutonium is not a significant or widespread NFSS contaminant.
