The monitoring equipment is an ISCO Avalanche sampler. It samples from location SWSD025 which is immediately north of IWCS in central drainage ditch. This location is shown on Figure 2 Surface Water and Sediment Sampling Locations at the Niagara Falls Storage Site (NFSS) of the NFSS Environmental Surveillance Enhancements Fact Sheet dated March 2011 that is available on our public website. Sampling frequency occurs, at a minimum, on a quarterly basis.
