

Corps of Engineers forming Ordnance panel

LEWISTON — The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is establishing a Restoration Advisory Board for the former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works site and will accept names to work with the group until April 16.

A 7,500-acre portion of the site was used in the early 1940s by the former U.S. War Department to produce and store TNT. The board will likely consist of representatives from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, from state and local agencies, current landowners, and other citizens.
