

Corps of Engineers establishing Advisory Board

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is establishing a Restoration Advisory Board for the former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works site, located in Niagara County, NY. This Board will give the community the opportunity to regularly review progress and participate in dialogue with decision makers about restoration efforts at the site.

The Restoration Advisory Board will likely consist of representatives of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, the NYS DEC, local government, current landowners, as well as citizens who reflect the diverse interests of the local community. Restoration Advisory Board members will review and comment on plans, technical documents relating to the ongoing environmental studies, and restoration activities at the site. The Restoration Advisory Board will meet on a bi-monthly or quarterly basis and the meetings will be open to the public.

Restoration Advisory Board members will serve a two-year term and attend meetings regularly. A selection panel of community members will review community interest forms and make recommendations to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for selection to the Board.
