## U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS SCHEDULES NEWS CONFERENCE ON FORMERLY UTILIZED SITES REMEDIAL ACTION PROGRAM (FUSRAP)

BUFFALO, N.Y. - The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Buffalo District has scheduled a news conference at the Buffalo District Office, 1776 Niagara St. on Wednesday, March 6 at 10:00 a.m. Lt. Col. Glen R. DeWillie, the Corps' Buffalo District Commander, and James W. Karsten, FUSRAP Program Manager will provide updated information on the status of hazardous waste cleanup projects in western New York. Projects discussed will include the Niagara Falls Storage Site and the Lake Ontario Ordnance Works Site.

The purpose of the news conference is to provide an update on the status of the cleanup projects under the Corps' management, status of the fiscal year 2002 budget for FUSRAP, and to answer specific technical questions related to cleanup activities at the sites.
