Feasibility Study and Proposed Plan Available Interim Waste Containment Structure Operable Unit Niagara Falls Storage Site Public Meeting January 13, 2016

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Buffalo District is pleased to announce the release of the feasibility study and proposed plan for the Interim Waste Containment Structure Operable Unit of the Niagara Falls Storage Site located in Lewiston, New York.

The proposed plan documents the Corps of Engineers' preferred alternative for the Interim Waste Containment Structure, which is Alternative 4, excavation, partial treatment, and off-site disposal of the entire contents of the IWCS.

The public is encouraged to review and provide their comments on the proposed plan. The public comment period for the proposed plan begins December 7, 2015, and ends February 6, 2016.

A public meeting will be conducted at the Town of Lewiston Senior Center, 4361 Lower River Road, Youngstown, NY 14171, on January 13, 2016, beginning at 6:30 p.m. A court recorder will be available to record verbal comments during the poster session, which begins at 7 p.m., and after the presentation.
