

#### Former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works Project Update - Remedial Investigation

- Objective
  - ◆ To assess potential environmental impacts to the former LOOW resulting exclusively from former Department of Defense use of the property
- Phase-I RI: Completed July 1999
- Phase II RI: In progress
  - Field work to be complete Dec 2000
  - ◆ Final Report In 2001



## Former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works Project Update - Interim Removal Actions

- TNT/CWS Remediation
  - ◆ All work on CWM property
  - ◆ TNT Line: 95% Complete
    - 450 feet remain to be completed in 2001
    - Powerwashing inside of pipeline
  - ◆ CWS Line: 100% Complete
    - Direct removal of underground piping



## Former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works Project Update - Interim Removal Actions

- Future Interim Removal Actions
  - Area-C Buried Wastes
    - Goal: Secure funds and remediate in 2001
  - Areas A&B Buried Wastes
    - Goal: Clean up in 2002
  - Other Removal Actions Being Evaluated
    - Building demolition

## Former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works Follow-Up From September RAB

- Corps to provide status of buildings at the LOOW Site (Town of Lewiston property)
  - ◆ Buffalo District pursuing funding mechanism for demolition of unsafe buildings and structures
  - ◆ Buffalo District will request funds. Funding availability not known at this time
  - We have made our chain of command aware of this situation
  - Will remain an action item

# Former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works Follow-Up From September RAB

- Aerial photography of school property
  - 1938: Active fruit orchards where schools now stand
  - 1944: No change fruit orchards remain. Southwestern drainage ditch constructed to divert flow of Twelve Mile Creek around the site (adjacent to current school property) to Four Mile Creek. Ditch remains today.
  - 1945: Property declared excess and sold to private owners
  - 1948 Present: Lew-Port Schools.



## Former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works Follow-Up From September RAB

- Groundwater flow is to north/northwest
- Winds are predominantly from the southwest to the northeast away from school property
- ◆ Former LOOW wastewater treatment plant located 3,125 feet to the east
  - 30-inch underground outfall line runs under school property to the Niagara River
  - Sealed at LOOW site in 1975 by Town of Lewiston
  - Still in service by Town of Lewiston

# Former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works Follow-Up From September RAB

- ◆ Outfall Line Sampling
  - No groundwater encountered
  - Sampled for Boron, Lithium, and TNT in soil/groundwater adjacent to and below the outfall pipe
  - Boron and Lithium detected but below screening criteria
  - No TNT detected



# Former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works Follow-Up From September RAB

#### Background Sampling

- 3 sampling locations on school property
  - 1 complete (near Southwestern Drainage Ditch)
  - 2 to be completed in November 2000
- 1 additional sampling location just south of school property line
- No monitoring wells due to lack of groundwater
- Sampling for hydrocarbons and metals
- No lab results yet. Results will be in final report

- Is any testing or monitoring of school water supply or air quality done?
- Has the school district communicated with adjacent property owners?
  - Any nearby sampling?
  - Historical use of property?
