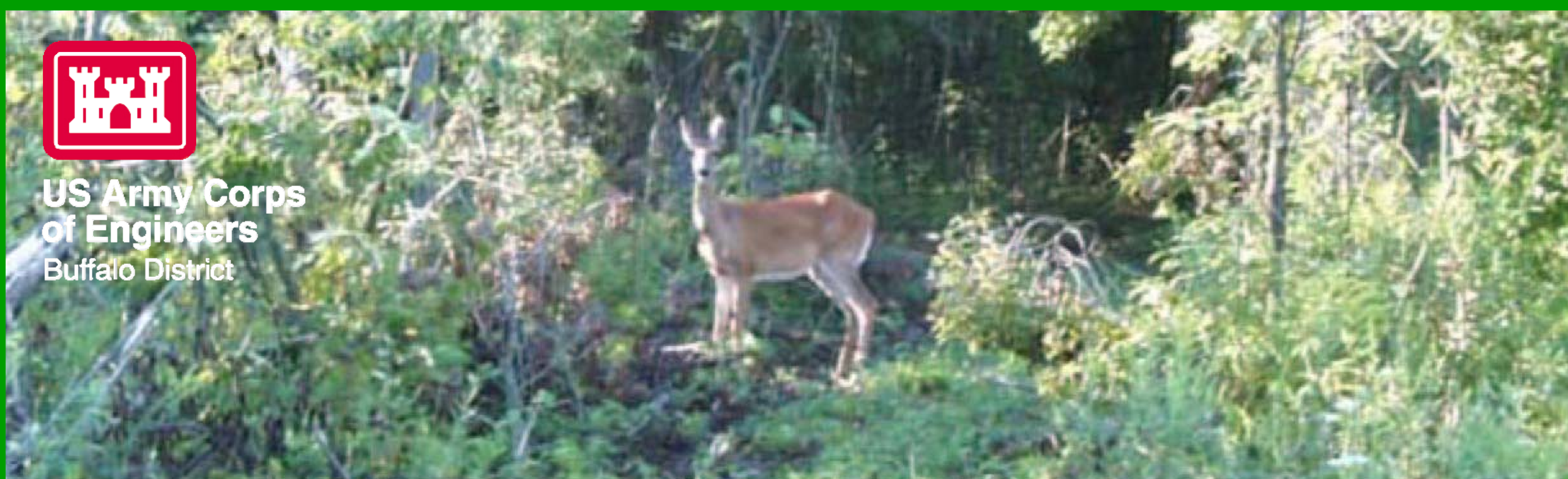
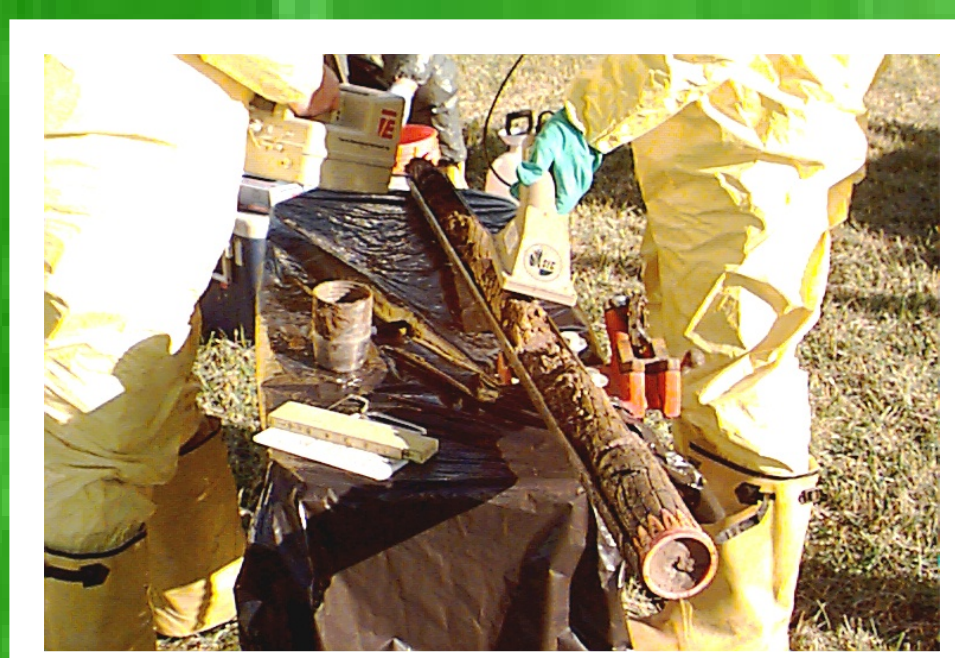

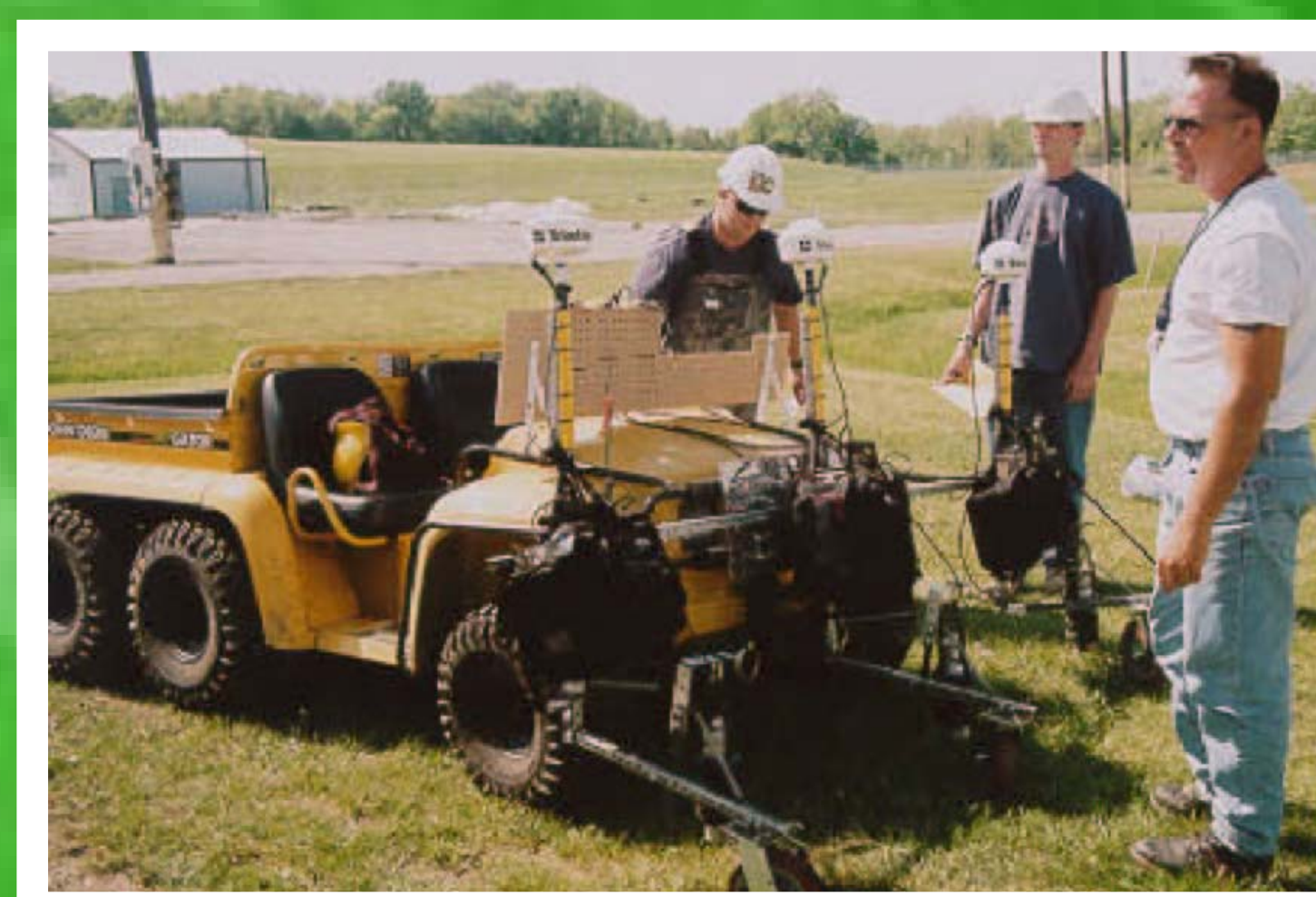


Subsurface soil sampling performed during the Remedial Investigation from 1999 to 2003.

A Gamma Walkover Survey of the NFSS was conducted during the summer of 2001 to evaluate the presence of surficial gamma-emitting radionuclides.



A Geophysical Survey of the NFSS was conducted during the summer of 2001.



Trenching activities performed at NFSS during the Remedial Investigation in 2002. Trenches were dug to confirm the presence or absence of subsurface irregularities.
