


# Soil Sorting System for the Painesville FUSRAP Site



Excavated soil is loaded into a screening system to remove large rocks and debris in a process called "pre-conditioning," prior to passing the soil on a conveyor through the segregating system.



Overview of the soil segregating system in use.



Soil passing under the radiation detectors is automatically segregated into piles above and below the cleanup criteria.



Segregated soil above the cleanup criteria will be loaded into gondola railcars for shipment to an appropriately permitted disposal facility.



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
