Good Morning [REDACTED]

I've attached an aerial photo of the Seaway site which identifies the approximate locations of the North side and South side excavation areas. Additional details concerning proposed remedial actions at the site can be found on the Seaway website:

The estimated volume of soil requiring excavation and removal is around 1000 CY. We are projecting field mobilization to take place in June with soil excavation and removal activities to occur during the summer (July/August/September). Because of the limited volume of soil requiring offsite disposal and condition of the rail siding south of the site, our contractor has chosen another transport option.

Work specifications which you inquired about will be detailed in the project work plans currently under developed. Once the plans are finalized they will be made available to local and state stakeholders and the public. Finalization of work plans is expected to occur in May followed by a Public Information session.

Hello

Appreciate your interest in the Seaway project and our upcoming remedial effort. As explained in the Seaway ROD (2009), remediation of the site consists of several parts: (1) Placement of a cap on the landfill portion of the site and, (2) Excavation and removal of FUSRAP contaminated soil from the northern and southern perimeter of the landfill (i.e. beyond the containment wall). Currently, we have funding to accomplish the excavation and removal of the contaminated soils which will occur this summer with an expected contractor mobilization in June. The placement of a landfill cap will occur at a future date dependent on the availability of funding in the FUSRAP program.

Prior to mobilization, we will conduct a public information session to present the historic basis and details of the planned removal process. Our outreach specialist will be notifying you and the public of the time, date and location of the public session in the coming weeks. I will be at the public meeting along with the Corps team and contractor representatives and will look forward to meeting you then.
