Dear [Redacted]:

The Town of Tonawanda Engineering Department will be involved with the FUSRAP project (Job 2463) and will be tracking hours during its involvement. This in-house practice is called "job tracking" which is done for all town projects that require engineering time. The initial project involvement was to formulate the right-of-entry agreement for the Ashland 1 and Ashland 2 staging area on town property. In addition to these sites, the Town of Tonawanda landfill FUSRAP area will require engineering time for remediation efforts during design and construction.

I would like to discuss with you the possibility of reimbursing the Town of Tonawanda with FUSRAP funds, for its engineering involvement. We estimate that this project would involve approximately 500-600 hours for engineering and over 43 months (February 1998 – August 2001). I will call you shortly to discuss this question.
