Dear ██████████:

This is in response to your letter dated August 6, 1998, requesting Corps of Engineers approval for the use of clean soil generated during the I-290 reconstruction project in the closure of the Town of Tonawanda Landfill. The Corps of Engineers has no objection to the use of this soil as additional cover over the presumed Department of Energy (DOE) waste area, if that is selected as the preferred closure alternative.

The Buffalo District is currently preparing a Radiological Risk Assessment for the Tonawanda Landfill. This document will evaluate radiological doses and risks for the present site condition, as well as for various closure scenarios. Once this Risk Assessment is completed, the Corps of Engineers will make a determination as to the preferred method of dealing with the presumed DOE waste material.
