This letter is a follow-up to the meeting held at the Corps complex on May 13, 2002 regarding the status of clean-up efforts at Tonawanda FUSRAP sites. I am requesting that you verify or clarify comments made regarding the status of the "mudflats" site so that town officials do not misrepresent the environmental conditions that presently exist in our discussions with potential developers of that site.

It is my understanding that the mudflats area is considered clean and ready for development with no contamination or "elevated activity." In a discussion with members of CANIT at a meeting today, however, it was pointed out that Corps officials made reference to a "hot spot" in the mudflats area caused by dumping activity and that this was a concern that had to be addressed. If this is the case, please advise us about this specific condition and how it should be addressed. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
