Dear Resident(s):

The meeting on the landfill issues on Feb. 8<sup>th</sup> at the Tonawanda High School was a clear indication of your frustration and concerns relative to the situation we now face. At that meeting, as per the agenda handed out, I was scheduled to speak just prior to the Question and Answer session but for whatever reason was not afforded that opportunity.

Therefore, I have put together a packet of information that summarizes the positions and initiatives that I and my Staff have made in reference to the issues brought forward at that meeting. In addition, you need to know that these initiatives date back to March 2006 after being in Office for less than three full months and almost a full year before the recently held meeting.

Also important is the fact that many of these initiatives were documented in writing so as to specifically represent our intentions as we attempt to protect the interest of our residents. This provides a permanent record of our goal to deal with the landfill issues in a manner that leaves no question of our intent.

Going forward, we will continue to aggressively work towards resolving the issues at the Town Landfill. We will continue to work with higher levels of government to get these issues resolved in a way that insures the health, safety and welfare of all families living along this landfill.
