The Town of Tonawanda Landfill and the Mudflats Area are currently designated under the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) as a Vicinity Property of the Linde FUSRAP site. FUSRAP is an environmental program created in 1974 to identify, investigate and take appropriate cleanup action at sites with radioactive contamination from activities that took place for the Nation's early atomic weapons program.

The Corps will be providing information in regards to the upcoming sampling of the Tonawanda Landfill and Mudflats Area and will be available to answer your questions.
