**INVITATION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT
ON THE
"FEASIBILITY STUDY/PROPOSED PLAN-
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT"
FOR THE TONAWANDA SITE**

The U.S. Department of Energy invites public comment on its recommended cleanup option discussed in the feasibility study and proposed plan documents for the Tonawanda Site that were issued on November 5, 1993. These documents present several options for cleaning up the radioactively contaminated properties in Tonawanda and DOE's recommended alternative for the cleanup. The public comment period has been extended 30 days and will now end on Feb. 10, 1994.
