

USACE Interagency and International Services



The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, through its Interagency and International Services (IIS) program, provides planning; engineering design and construction management; environmental services; and technical assistance related to water, and other natural resources, buildings' and infrastructure. Assistance can vary from highly specific technical advice to complete program management services.

- The requesting entity provides funding for these services. Reimbursable support is arranged through the execution of a written agreement.
- Corps of Engineers support to other agencies helps them meet their program challenges while avoiding duplication of federal capabilities and agency start up and closeout activities. Under the Corps' IIS program, state and local governments are able to access its unique support capabilities.
- The IIS program also enables other government agencies and the private sector to access cost-saving technologies and expertise from Corps of Engineers laboratories and technical centers of expertise.
- The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, through its IIS program, functions largely as a contract manager using the talents of the private sector to accomplish actual tasks. Highly competent government management support and private sector technical support is a combination that best serves the public interest and specific requirements of our IIS partners and customers.
