Condition of Federal Navigation Channel Dunkirk Harbor, Dunkirk, New York

1. Condition surveys performed within the Federal Navigation Channel at Dunkirk Harbor, Dunkirk, New York during the months of July and August 2014 indicate shoaling has reduced depths to those shown on the attached standard tabular form and channel condition drawings.
2. Soundings are in feet and referred to Low Water Datum (LWD) 569.2 feet above Mean Water Level (MWL) at Rimouski, Quebec (International Great Lakes Datum 1985).
3. Vessel operators are advised to use caution when navigating in this area.
4. Copies of the sounding print for Dunkirk Harbor, New York consisting of (2) sheets, duk14pcvh101-2 and duk14pcvh102-2, at a cost of \$2.50 per sheet will be furnished upon receipt of a check in the full amount made payable to: USACE Finance and Accounting.
