TINKERS CREEK, STREETSBORO - OH
Small Flood Control Projects

Section 205 of the Flood Control Act of 1948, as amended
Construction General (Continuing Authorities Program)

Location

- Western portion of State Route 303 and Tinker's Creek in the city of Streetsboro, OH (Portage County); 30 miles southeast of Cleveland, OH

Project Description

- The Section 205 Authority provides for local protection from flooding by the construction or improvement of flood control works such as levees, channels, and dams
- Feasibility phase is cost-shared 50% Federal and 50% non-Federal
- Design and Implementation is cost-shared 65% Federal and 35% non-Federal

Importance

- State Route 303 can flood up to 4,000 linear feet (about 3/4 of a mile) within a few minutes
- City unable to fulfill its mutual aid agreements with cities to the west during flood events

Consequences

- If a project is not pursued, the city will continue to incur financial damages related to flood events


