Location

- Willowick Service Department, 31230 Vine Street, Willowick, Ohio 44095

Project Description

- Storm water sewer improvements
- Authorization - WRDA 2007 Sec. 5158 (218) - \$665,000 for wastewater infrastructure, Willowick OH
- Design and/or Construction are cost-shared 75% Federal and 25% non-Federal

Importance

- Capital improvements will allow the facilities to continue to serve the storm/waste water treatment needs of the City of Willowick in accordance with all US Environmental Protection Agency and OH Environmental Protection Agency issued permits

Consequences

- System failure will occur without upgrade or replacement
- The risk of partially treated/untreated wastewater being discharged increases without improvements to the existing system


