Location

- Carl B. Stokes Building, 1201 Lakeside Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44114

Project Description

- The purpose of the project is to improve, create, and relocate sewer infrastructures essential to the overall Flats East Bank redevelopment project
- Authorization - WRDA 2007 Sec. 5158 (207) - \$2,500,000 for water and wastewater infrastructure, Flats East Bank, Cleveland County, OH
- Design and/or Construction is cost-shared 75% Federal and 25% non-Federal

Importance

- Capital improvements will continue to serve the waste water needs of the city of Cleveland in accordance with all U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and OH Environmental Protection Agency issued permits

Consequences

- System failure will occur without upgrade or replacement of existing infrastructure
- The risk of partially treated/untreated wastewater being discharged increases without improvements to the current system


