### PIPE CREEK, SANDUSKY, OH

#### Small Flood Control Projects

February 2015

Section 205 of the Flood Control Act of 1948, as amended  
Construction General (Continuing Authorities Program)

#### Location

- In Erie County, OH approximately 60 miles west of Cleveland, OH
- Pipe Creek between Campbell Street and Milan Road

#### Project Description

- The Section 205 Authority provides for local protection from flooding by the construction or improvement of flood control works such as levees, channels, and dams
- Feasibility phase is cost-shared 50% Federal and 50% non-Federal

- Design and Implementation is cost-shared 65% Federal and 35% non-Federal

#### Importance

- To help alleviate the severity of flooding and associated degradation that has repeatedly caused extensive damages to residents throughout the County in recent years

#### Consequences

- If a project is not pursued, the city will continue to incur financial damages related to flood events



