Environmental Infrastructure Program

Location

- The city of Fostoria, in northwestern OH

Project Description

- Eliminate or reduce combined sewer overflow (CSO) in response to Federal and State consent decrees
- Upgrades and expansion of the existing wastewater treatment plant and the separation of combined sewers
- Authorization - WRDA 2007 Sec. 5158 (211) - \$2,000,000 for water related infrastructure in Fostoria
- Design and/or Construction is cost-shared 75% Federal and 25% non-Federal

Importance

- The City of Fostoria is under a consent decree to improve current operation of the city's wastewater treatment plant and implement construction to control CSO discharges

Consequences

- System failure will occur without upgrade or replacement
- The risk of partially treated/untreated waste water being discharged increases without improvements to the existing system
