SOUTH TOLEDO, SWAN CREEK – OH
Emergency Streambank Erosion Protection for Public Facilities
 Section 14, Flood Control Act of 1946, as amended
 Construction General (Continuing Authorities Program)

Location

- City of Toledo, Lucas County, Ohio
- Nelson Avenue which is on the opposite side of the existing Swan Creek Flood Damage Reduction Project
- There is a separate Section 14 project across the road from this site, Swan Creek, City of Toledo, OH

Project Description

- Bank erosion along Swan Creek is jeopardizing Nelson Avenue
- The study would investigate alternatives for streambank stabilization at the site
- Feasibility phase is cost-shared 50% Federal and 50% non-Federal

- Design and Implementation is cost-shared 65% Federal and 35% non-Federal

Importance

- Nelson Avenue is a residential street with public utilities

Consequences

- Continued erosion and lack of stream bank stabilization will eventually lead to breaching and possible loss of sections of Nelson Avenue and public utilities


