Aurora Pond and Northwest tributary	Summit, Portage	Reminderville, Geauga Lake, Twinsburg	Aurora Pond, in its entirety, is included in the TNW designation. The northwestern tributary flows southeast along Nautilus Trail then discharges into Aurora Pond. The limits of the TNW designation of the tributary are from Glenwood Drive to Aurora Pond. Completed 6/30/2008.
Brady Lake	Portage	Franklin	All areas below the Ordinary High Water Mark (OHWM) of Brady Lake located within the Village of Brady Lake and Franklin Township, Portage County, Ohio at coordinates 41.16444° N (Lat.) and -81.31615° W (Long.). The limits of this TNW designation do not preclude future determinations of the water body if additional information warrants such a determination
Chagrin River	Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake	Eastlake, Willoughby, Willoughby Hills, Russell, Newbury, Munson, Waite Hill, Gate Mills, Hunting Valley, Moreland Hills, Bentleyville, Chagrin Falls	All areas below the Ordinary High Water Mark (OHWM) of the Chagrin River encompassing Bass Lake, just southwest of Chardon, Munson Township, Geauga County, downstream to the Section 10 designated area of the Chagrin River (1.5 miles upstream from the confluence with Lake Erie) City of Eastlake, Lake County. This TNW designation does not extend into any of the tributaries of the Chagrin River. The limits of this TNW designation do not preclude future determinations for undesignated portions of the water body if additional information warrants such a determination. Completed 08/06/2008
Cuyahoga River, Lake Rockwell, LaDue Reservoir (upstream to U.S. Rte 422) and Bridge Creek	Geauga, Portage, Summit	Akron, Mantua, Streetsboro, Kent, Cuyahoga Falls, Munroe Falls, Tallmadge, Burton, Franklin, Hiram, Mantua, Shalersville, Troy, Auburn,	This designation includes all areas below the ordinary high water mark of the Cuyahoga River extending from the upstream limits at the confluence of the East Branch and West Branch of the Cuyahoga River in the Town of Burton, Geauga County, to the downstream confluence with the Little Cuyahoga River in the City of North Akron, Summit County, Ohio. Additionally, this designation includes LaDue Reservoir and Bridge Creek from the U.S. Route 422 crossing in Auburn Township, Geauga County downstream to the confluence of Bridge Creek and the Cuyahoga River in Troy Township, Geauga County. Completed 7/17/2008.

¹ This list represents TNW designations for waters that are determined to be navigable-in-fact and regulated under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (CWA). This list does not represent TNWs regulated under Section 10 of the River and Harbors Act, as well as Section 404 of the CWA.
