

MEMORANDUM FOR LTC Karl D. Jansen, Buffalo District Commander
SUBJECT: Activation of Emergency Regional Permit No. 99-000-1, Remediation of Storm Damage.

1. Recent severe weather with significantly higher than normal rainfall has occurred throughout Allegany, Cattaraugus, Chautauqua, Erie and Wyoming Counties, New York between July 13-14, 2015, resulting in flooding and subsequently adverse affects to streams.
2. The Corps has contacted all potentially affected Soil and Water Conservation Districts, who have indicated that permitting needs are likely as a result of the storm related damage. Once activated, the Regulatory Branch Chief may add additional counties to this activation as they are identified.
3. Emergency Regional Permit 99-000-1 is designed to allow a quick and consistent response by the Buffalo District for public requests to remediate storm damages. This authorization streamlines the decision-making process, reduces paperwork burdens and insures that the public is aware of the required environmental conditions that are necessary prior to initiating work.
4. Request that you immediately activate this permit. Applicants will have one year from the activation date to complete the authorized work.
