The US Army Corps of Engineers (the Corps) is sending this e-mail to those individuals who have expressed interest in our projects at the former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works (LOOW) Site.

Lieutenant Colonel John S. Hurley, Buffalo District Commander, thoroughly reviewed input received from the community, elected officials, government agencies and non-government organizations on the establishment of an official Department of Defense (DoD) Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) for the former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works (LOOW) Site located in the towns of Lewiston and Porter, New York. After careful consideration of the comments received, it was decided not to establish an official DoD RAB.
