Dear Mr. Wiepert,

The next meeting of the Lake Ontario Ordnance Works Site Restoration Advisory Board is scheduled for July 12 from 7:00 to 9:00 at the Lewiston Porter Central School District's Primary Building at 406 1 Creek Road.

You may recall that in my last report to you, which I mailed on April 13, I mentioned that I would be unavailable and that you may appoint an alternate for me if you wish to do so.
