Details of Call After calling Bob Weyth at Recrea
I called R. Medary of COE and and
explained Recrea's costs. Basically the itemized
cost for matrix spike (MS) and matrix spike
duplicate (MSD) analyses is a result of CLP
invoicing requirements. Prior to CLP
participation, laboratory would build the cost
of Lab QC into the unit price rates for
the analysis. CLP invoicing requires
that these analyses be broken out and
shown separately. As a result, unit prices
are lower but now MS & MSD analyses are charged
separately. What is important for the COE
and Recrea is that we are not paying
double for the required analyses. Richard
said he had called CompuChem Laboratory
to see how they price their analysis and
they essentially confirmed that charging
for MS and MSD analysis is a result of
the CLP. CompuChem however said they
include that cost in their unit prices but discount
the unit price if MS & MSD Results from samples
other than the client's sample are acceptable. Richard
agreed that this issue is resolved and the number
of chargeable samples required is valid
