Dear Mr. Furst:

On September 28, 1987, our office sent a letter to your facility along with information pertaining to Federal facility pre-remedial activity requirements for the Superfund program. As you are aware, the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986 (SARA) mandates that every Federal agency complete a Preliminary Assessment (PA), and where applicable, a Site Investigation (SI) for each of their facilities on the initial Federal Agency Hazardous Waste Compliance Docket ("docket") by April 1988. This information will then be assessed by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to determine if further remedial investigation and action is required. Since your facility has been listed on the initial docket as published in the February 12, 1988 Federal Register (see attached), you will be required to submit the above-mentioned information to us.

The enclosed PA must be completed and returned to this office by April 17, 1988. Please be aware that further information may be requested upon EPA's review of the PA. All submitted information will enable the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to rank the facility, if appropriate, under the Hazard Ranking System (HRS) for possible inclusion on the National Priorities List (NPL). By April 1989, EPA must determine which facilities should be placed on the NPL. Please note that Department of Defense Installation Restoration Program reports or equivalent may be submitted in lieu of, or in addition to, PA and SI forms if the reports contain all information EPA will require to complete the HRS.
