This is in response to your letter of September 28, 1988, which requested information regarding our RI/FS of the former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works. You specifically requested a copy of the preinvestigation documents (i.e. work plan, etc) for the project. This information would aid you in meeting the requirements of the 3008(h) Administrative Order on Consent entered into with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region II.

In accordance with your request I have enclosed one copy each of the following documents:

CWM Chemical Services, Inc. has recently entered into a 3008(h) Administrative Order on Consent with the EPA Region II to conduct an RFI Investigation of its Model City Facility. We are required by the order to send a copy to any third party that is conducting work or tasks relating to the investigation of releases and/or evaluations of Corrective Action at the site. Since the Corps of Engineers has the Acres International Corporation conducting a RI/FS at the Model City facility, you are being provided the attached copy of the order.

Your attention is invited to Attachment A, Section III A 1, to the order which requires CWM to include in its Project Management Plan (PMP) provision for the monitoring of RFI tasks being conducted by or on behalf of third parties, i.e., the Department of Energy or Department of Defense. This provision has been included in our PMP which is subject to EPA review and approval. To facilitate our monitoring of the DOD's, RI/FS, I would appreciate a copy of the final RI/FS Plans that have been prepared for the Corps by Acres. Further, I would appreciate being notified of the timing of Acres field activities so selected tasks can be observed.
