Lt. Col. Jason A. Toth assumed the duties of district commander of the Buffalo District on June 29, 2018. Prior to this assignment, he served as the deputy district commander of the St. Paul District.

Lt. Col. Toth hails from northwestern Indiana and received his commission in May of 2000 from the United States Military Academy at West Point, New York. In addition to his commission, he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in civil engineering from the United States Military. He holds Masters of Science degrees in geological engineering from the University of Missouri at Rolla, Missouri, and civil engineering from Stanford University, California. He is also a licensed Professional Engineer in the state of Missouri.



His initial assignment was with the 555<sup>th</sup> Engineer Brigade at Ft. Lewis, Washington, where he served as platoon leader and company executive officer in A Company, 14<sup>th</sup> Engineer Battalion. He participated in Operation Iraqi Freedom first as a company executive officer and then as an assistant battalion operations officer. Following the Engineer Officer Advanced Course, he served as an engineer planner with the 8<sup>th</sup> US Army Headquarters in Youngsan Garrison, South Korea. He subsequently commanded Headquarters Support Company, 19<sup>th</sup> Engineer Battalion, based out of Ft. Knox, Kentucky. His company command included an operational deployment to Tikrit, Iraq. Post-command, he completed graduate work at Stanford and joined the faculty of the United States Military civil and mechanical engineer department, where he taught civil engineering for three years as an instructor and assistant professor. Prior to his most recent assignment, he served as an executive officer for the 588 Brigade Engineer Battalion the chief of Operations and Brigade Engineer for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Armored Brigade Combat Team, 4<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, Ft. Carson, Colorado. During this time, he deployed to Kuwait with the 3<sup>rd</sup> Armor Brigade Combat Team, 4<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, in support of Operation Spartan Shield.

Lt. Col. Toth is a graduate of the Engineer Officer Basic and Advanced Courses; the Army Command and General Staff College; the Air Force Command and Staff College; and the Army Airborne and Sapper Leader Schools. His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal, the Army Commendation Medal, the Army Achievement Medal, the Volunteer Service Medal and the Combat Action Badge.

His operational deployments include, Operation Iraqi Freedom I and 06-08 and Operation Spartan Shield 14 and 15.
