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Corps of Engineers completes remedial investigation of Former Guterl Specialty Steel Site

BUFFALO, NY--The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Buffalo District has completed their Remedial Investigation Report for the former Guterl Specialty Steel located in Lockport, NY.

The Remedial Investigation Report documents the nature and extent of radiological contamination at the site resulting from the Nation's early atomic weapons and energy programs under the Manhattan Engineer District and the Atomic Energy Commission.

The Remedial Investigation Report also evaluated potential risks to human health and the environment from identified contamination and found that there is no imminent threat to public safety or human health at the site.

The Corps will move forward to the feasibility phase of the project to identify and evaluate potential remedial alternatives to eliminate risks to human health and the environment appropriate for the future land use of the site.
