You are invited to a poster session for the former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works (LOOW) on **Wednesday, June 10, 2015, in the Lewiston Porter Senior Center, 4361 Lower River Road, Youngstown, NY 14174.** The poster session will be conducted in an open house fashion with project delivery team members available to talk with you between **5:30 and 7 p.m.**

The former LOOW is located in the towns of Lewiston and Porter, Niagara County, New York, and was used during World War II as a trinitrotoluene (TNT) manufacturing facility. The former LOOW is being addressed under the Defense Environmental Restoration Program for Formerly Used Defense Sites in accordance with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (42 U.S.C § 9601 et.seq.), as amended, and the National Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Contingency Plan (40 CFR 300).

Posters with the latest information regarding the LOOW Management Action Plan, the Occidental Chemical Corporation Property, and the former LOOW Wastewater Treatment Plant will be on display.

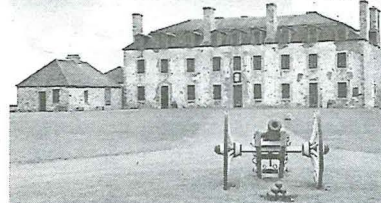
