The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Buffalo District, is pleased to provide the enclosed compact disk containing the *Final Groundwater Monitoring Well Decommissioning Completion Report for the Former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works (LOOW) Site, Niagara County, New York*.

This completion report documents the successful decommissioning of unserviceable or inactive monitoring wells at the Former LOOW. Specifically, a total of 19 monitoring wells were decommissioned on Somerset property (16 wells) and the Chemical Waste Management Chemical Services, LLC property (3 wells) during March 18-22, 2013. As you are aware, the decommissioning work plans for this activity were released and provided for your review in January 2013. The work was performed under the Defense Environmental Restoration Program for Formerly Used Defense Sites (DERP-FUDS) and in accordance with New York State Department of Environmental Conservation guidance.
